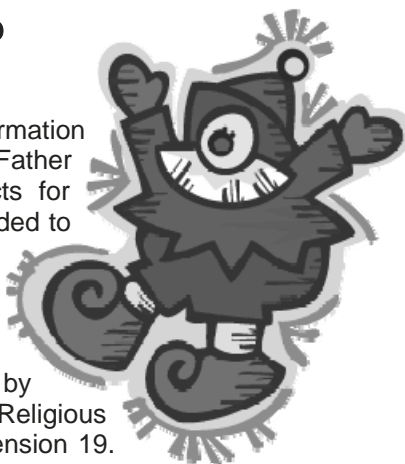
St. Nicholas Workshop Volunteers Needed

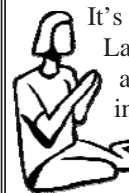

A Mission: Possible Moment...

Jesus tells us in today's Gospel that those who are faithful in small matters will be given great responsibilities. Many of us serving in ministry today can reflect back on our own "small" responses to the Gospel call, which led us eventually into greater responsibilities.

Protecting God's Children

Your gifts to the Catholic Services Appeal ensure parishes are safe-havens for our children. Developing child-safe environments is the goal of the **Protecting God's Children** child sexual abuse prevention program.

Protecting God's Children educates and trains adults about the dangers of abuse, the warning signs of abuse and the ways to prevent abuse. It also details the methods of properly reporting suspicions and responding to allegations of abuse.

All parishes are required to train their pastoral staff members, as well as volunteers who work with children, through a Protecting God's Children workshop. Workshops are held at various parishes throughout the year. This week, Protecting God's Children workshops will be held at Sacred Heart Parish, Dearborn; St. Paul of Tarsus Parish, Clinton Township; St. Joseph Parish, Wyandotte; and Holy Family Parish, Memphis.
