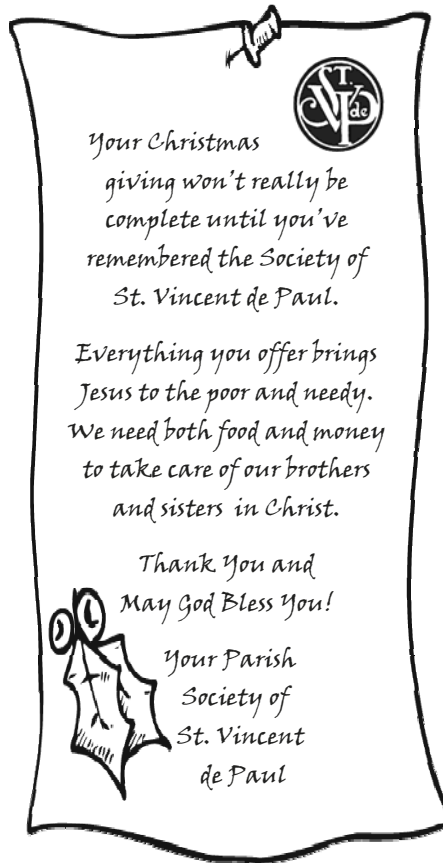


Our basketball season has just started but the Broncos are already thinking Spring!

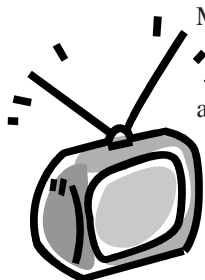

Many homebound elderly people in our community need to transition their analog televisions into digital before the February deadline; however, they do not have the funds or ability to make the transfer themselves.

Catholic Social Services of Oakland County's Retired and Senior Volunteer Program participants are helping the homebound elderly by purchasing the equipment and installing it directly in the home. Help make this happen by donating coupons that offset the cost.

The Federal Government is offering U.S. households up to two \$40 coupons to help with the cost of certified TV converter boxes.
